

## Rothesay Yacht Club Learn to Sail Program Rules and Discipline Policy

This form acknowledges you have read and understood the RYC Sailor Safety Rules and Code of Conduct. Failure to comply with the expectations will result in penalties and consequences. The RYC disciplinary system works on a three-strike policy.

First Strike - The sailor will be warned by an instructor. The strike will be recorded on the sailor's file and the Learn to Sail Director (LTSD) will be notified.

Second Strike - The sailor will be warned by an instructor. The sailor may be asked to sit out the rest of the class/day. Parent/guardian will be informed and asked to meet the LTSD to discuss the first and second transgressions and to make a plan to avoid any further misbehavior. The strike and meeting notes will be documented in the sailor's file.

Third Strike - The sailor will be asked to sit out for the rest of the day, for the rest of the week or for the remainder of the session, depending on the severity of the incident. Parent/guardian will be informed and asked to meet with the LTSD. The Commodore will also be informed. The strike will be documented in the sailor's file.

Continued abuse of the rules by a sailor participant will result in expulsion from the program. Parent/guardian and the Commodore will be informed. The strike will be documented in the sailor's file. No fee will be refunded.
